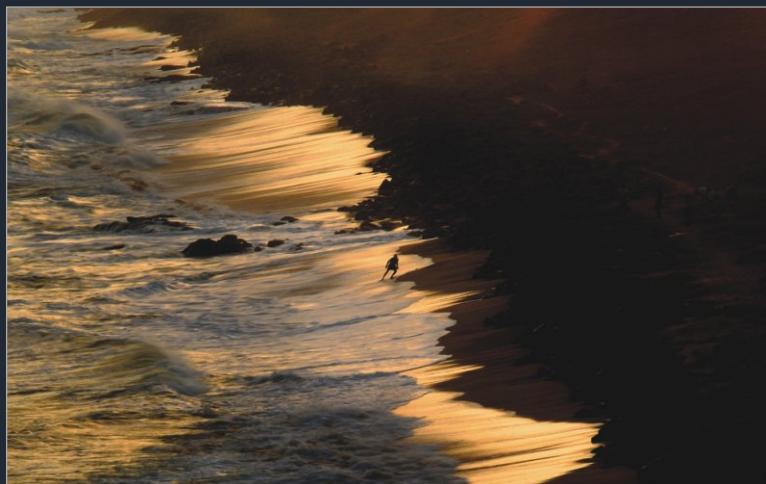
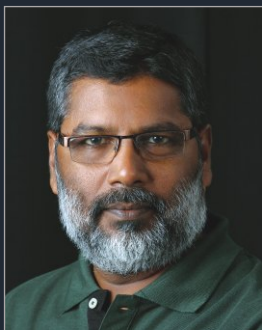
Ambily Pravda
